Turn your old electronics into community impact this October

Tempe, AZ – Tempe Community Council (TCC) is partnering with TechRec Recycling to make it easier than ever for the community to recycle electronics and give back. Blue donation bins will be available at the City of Tempe EnVision Center (1310 E Apache Blvd) from October 1–31.

For every laptop, computer, smartphone, tablet, or video game console donated, TechRec will contribute \$5 to support Tempe Community Council programs. Additionally, 10% of proceeds from all other donated items will also benefit TCC's impactful community initiatives. Any item that connects to electricity, including cords and cables, can be donated and recycled.
